WHEREAS:	As Delta Air Service, the airline's first flights took off four years later; and
WHEREAS:	Today, Delta maintains a team of 100,000 people delivering a world-class customer experience on over 4,000 daily flights; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota is Delta's second home, serving as its northern headquarters. The Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport (MSP) is Delta's second largest hub in the world; and
WHEREAS:	In addition to the hub at MSP, Delta also serves key regional economic centers in Minnesota: Bemidji, Brainerd, Duluth, Hibbing, International Falls, and Rochester; and
WHEREAS:	Delta's world-class connectivity helps keep Minnesota's economy strong. With over 140 nonstop destinations on over 350 peak day flights, Delta connects thousands of people around the globe to and through Minnesota every day. This includes direct flights from MSP to key international destinations such as London, Paris, Tokyo, Seoul, Amsterdam, Dublin, Reykjavik, and Mexico City. Delta will also be starting direct service this year to Rome and Copenhagen; and
WHEREAS:	Delta continues to build on its commitment to Minnesota and maintains dedicated partnerships with the state's university system and technical colleges, including Lake Superior College, Minneapolis Community and Technical College, and Minnesota State University, to produce the next generation of aviation professionals.
